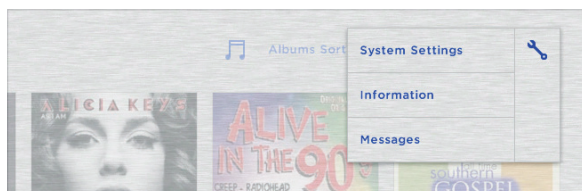


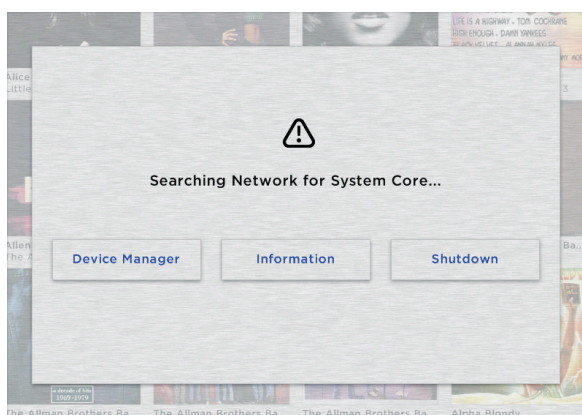

User Interface: Updates, Enhancements and Changes

Home Screen Changes: The Home Screen has been eliminated. Settings and information are available from the settings icon in the upper right of the screen.



New Onscreen Trouble Communications: “Searching Network for System Core” and “Searching Network for Sooloos Storage” have replaced the “Locating Sooloos Source” and “Locating Sooloos Stores” messages.



Messages: The settings icon in the upper right will turn into a green message icon whenever there is a message in the system.

The most important message will be notification of updates.

System updates are no longer automatic. When an update is available, there will be a message prompting you to download and apply the update.

We anticipate several updates over the course of the year. With this in mind, we wanted to avoid some of the problems that can occur with automatic updates, for example devices occasionally becoming out of sync with one another.

It is easier to inform users about the nature of the update and communicate how new features work when they are actively involved in the update process.

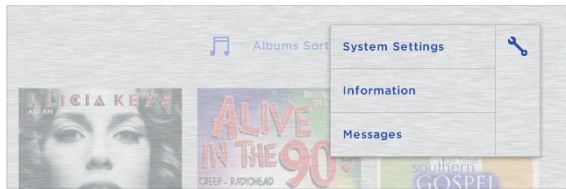


Shutdown Options: Shutdown options are now available through the sleep icon located at the bottom left of the Home screen.

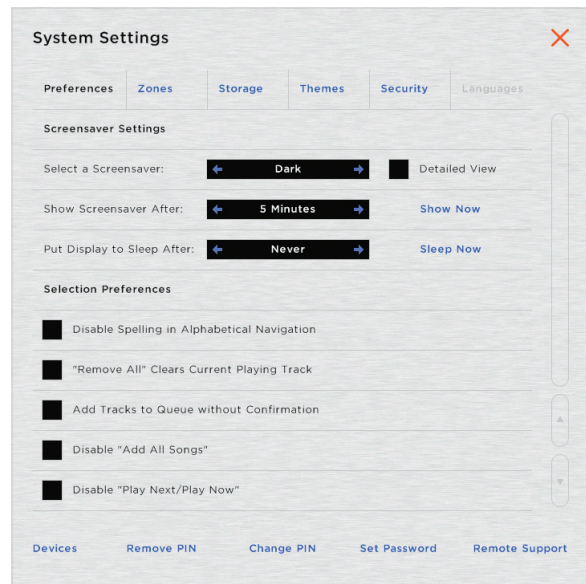
System Setup Changes:

The System Setup functions (previously accessible only during the Control's startup sequence) have moved to the Device Manager page. To reach these functions, tap the Settings icon in the upper right of the cover browser, and tap "Settings." In the Settings screen, tap "Devices" in the lower left.

You will notice a great deal of new information here, including version and build numbers, IP addresses and other useful information for troubleshooting.

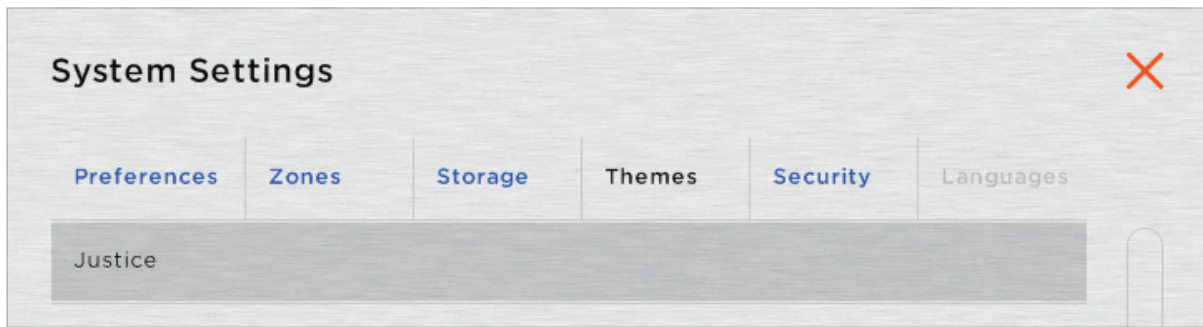

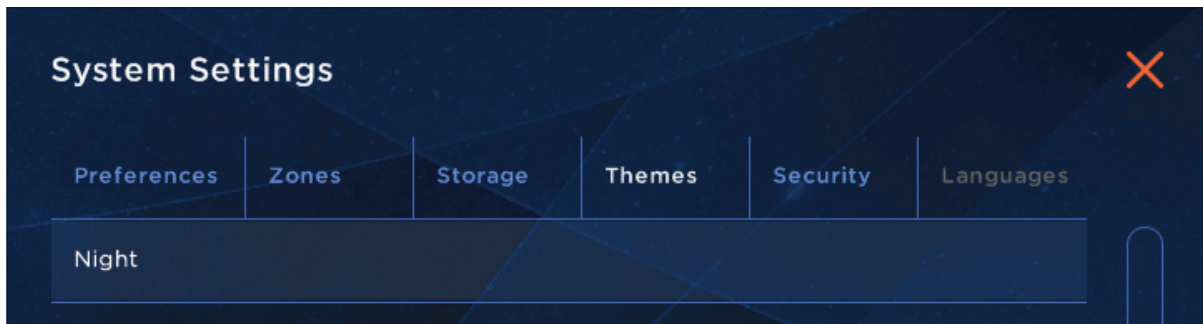

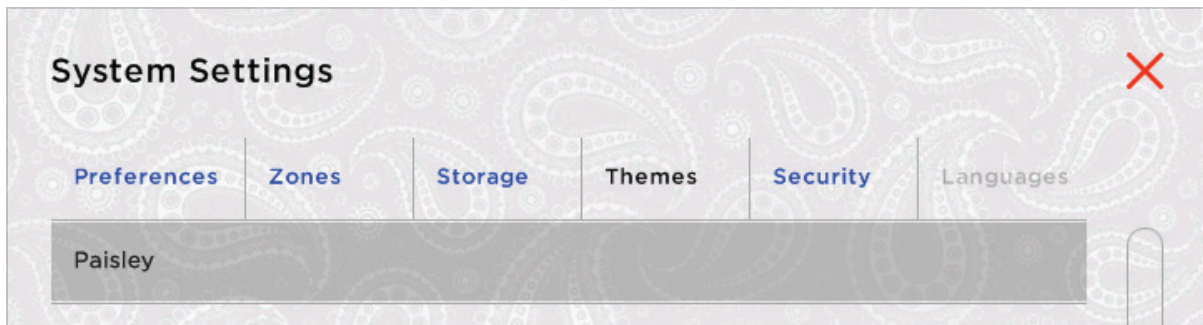

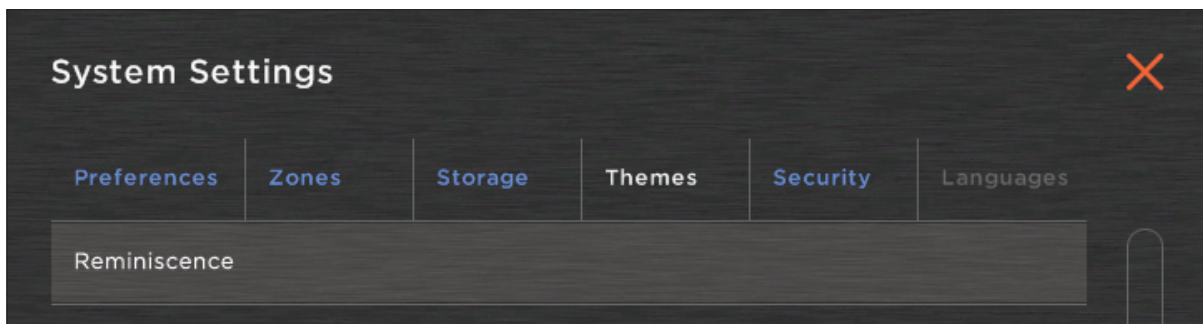
SYSTEM SETTINGS: JUSTICE THEME

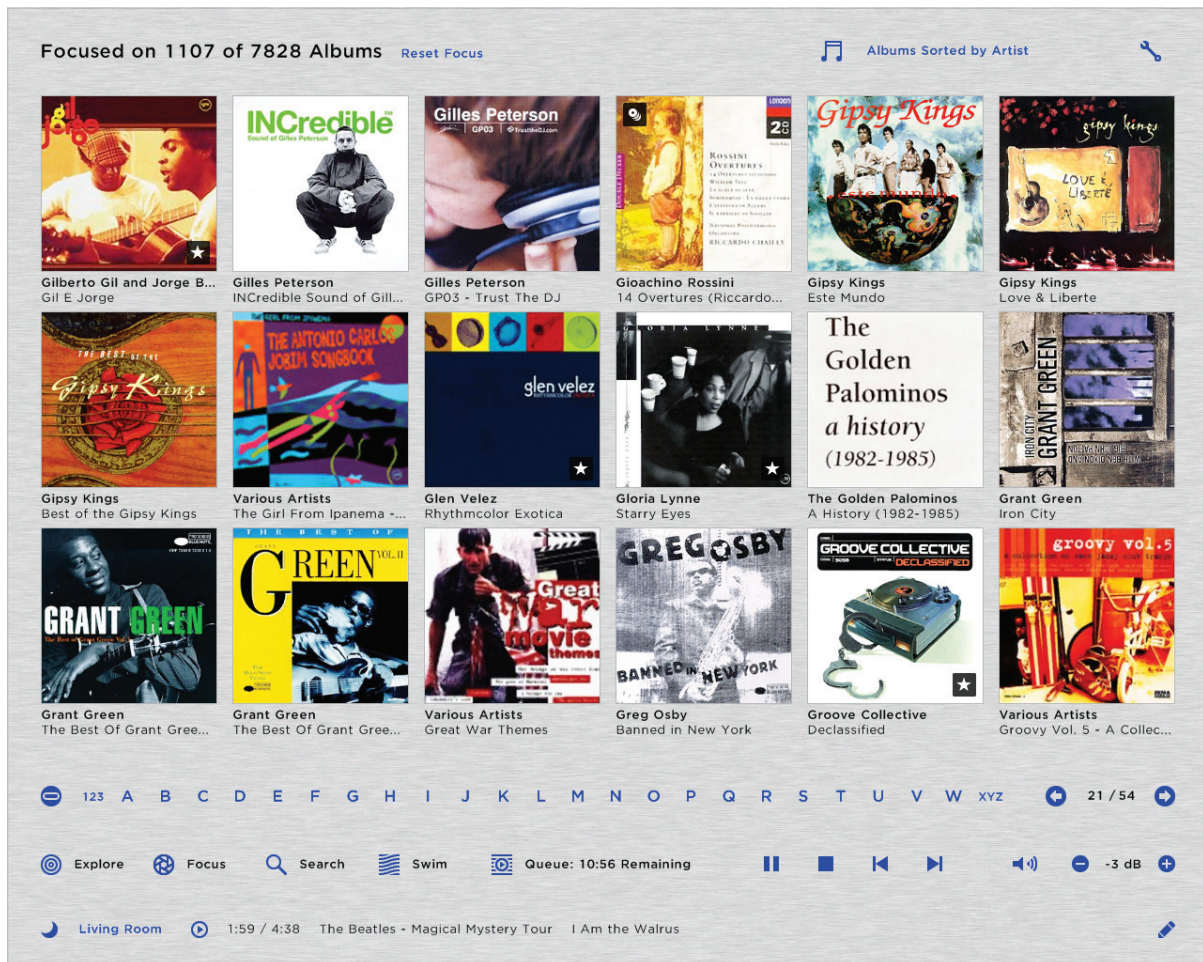

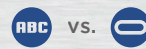
Focus Status and Reset Focus: In the upper lefthand corner, the Focus Status tells you how many albums you are viewing. If your Focus is narrowed away from the whole collection, then there will be a "Reset Focus" option next to the Focus Status to return to viewing the whole collection.

View: [Albums Sorted by Artist](#)

Album Views: Tap here to switch from the default view of Albums listed by Artist. There will be more options in the near future, including View by Artist (this will take your 14 Dylan albums and display just one cover) to shrink a large collection to just artists, and View by Composer, ideal for Classical users.



Tap to access settings, information, and messages.



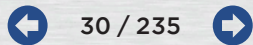
Slider vs. Alpha Navigation: You now have the choice of two different methods of navigation.

Traditional, alphabetical, navigation displays the alphabet from A-Z and allows you to tap in a single letter, or series of letters.

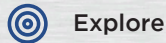
Scrolling/Slider based navigation is similar to the scroll bars on your computer's operating system.

You can toggle between the two methods by tapping on the navigation icon (shown above) located to the left of the navigation bar.

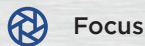

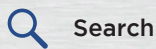
Browser Controls: Tap the previous and next page arrows to advance the browser one page at a time or touch and hold the arrow icon to rapidly scroll through pages.



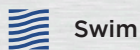
Explore: This is the same as the folder tree view of Control PC and Control Mac. It is not as useful as the Cover Browser for finding the album you are looking for but is a very cool way to leaf through genres, decades, etc.



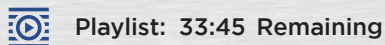
Opens the **Focus** page.



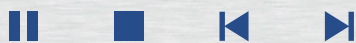
Opens the **Search** page.



Swim is now up front and accessible with a new icon. When you tap, you see a list of common focuses to select from to swim in, or can pick a saved focus or tags.



Play Queue is changing to Playlist: Using both the words Playlist and Play Queue was confusing and Playlist is the more commonly used word, so it is now used consistently.



Playback Controls: Pause, Stop, Previous Track and Next Track all function as before.



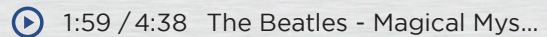
Volume Control is in the Cover Browser, always accessible, and very usable in its feel and volume scaling. By default it is disabled and can be activated, per zone. Go Home/Settings/Devices and tap on a zone. Uncheck "Fixed Output Volume".



Sleep: Tapping the sleep icon gives you the option of opening the screen saver or sleeping the display.

Living Room

Quick Zone Linking: Tap the zone name to bring up a list of zones. Then tap to select the zone to control.



Now Playing Page: Tap the Now Playing info to open this page. This page replaces the information that was previously located on the Play Queue page (including tapping the progress bar to seek within the track).



Select and Edit: Use this feature to select multiple items to apply the same action to all of them – quickly deleting a bunch of albums, changing ratings, tagging a bunch of albums. Simply tap multiple albums, which will turn them blue, and then pick an action to apply to them all.

There is one other very important new action to take note of: **"Create Album Set."** This is to make multi-disc sets appear as one cover. Tap the albums of a set and they will turn blue. Tap "Create Album Set" and they will now appear as one cover in your cover browser.

Focus on Similar Albums

Focus on Similar Albums: We've changed the criteria used by this feature. You will get better results.



Track/Album Picks and Skips: Pick albums and tracks are more likely to be played in a swim. But what if you never want a track or album to come up? Rap intros or audiobooks or comedy albums are not things that keep a party going. So you can make a track or album a "Skip" track or album. And you can do it from the Album Detail Page or the Now Playing Page. Just tap the star to cycle through the options.

Tags

Tags have replaced Collections. Currently existing Collections will be converted to Tags. To apply tags to albums, go into "Select and Edit" mode and tap the albums you want to tag.

Edit Album Metadata

All Metadata can now be edited from the Control.

Artist Information

Artist Information: This page has limited use now but will have more in the future. One very important aspect of this feature is the ability to change the Sort word for the artist. If you want David Bowie to come up under "Bowie" instead of "David," change this here. This is a valuable tool for Classical users.

Trio in c Minor Op. 1 No. 3

Classical Works: In classical music the overall work is more important than the individual tracks. We look for words that appear in common across track titles and automatically create a "Work" title by assuming they go together. The user can force the creation of a work or change the title of a work by changing the titles of the tracks in the work.

Included Item

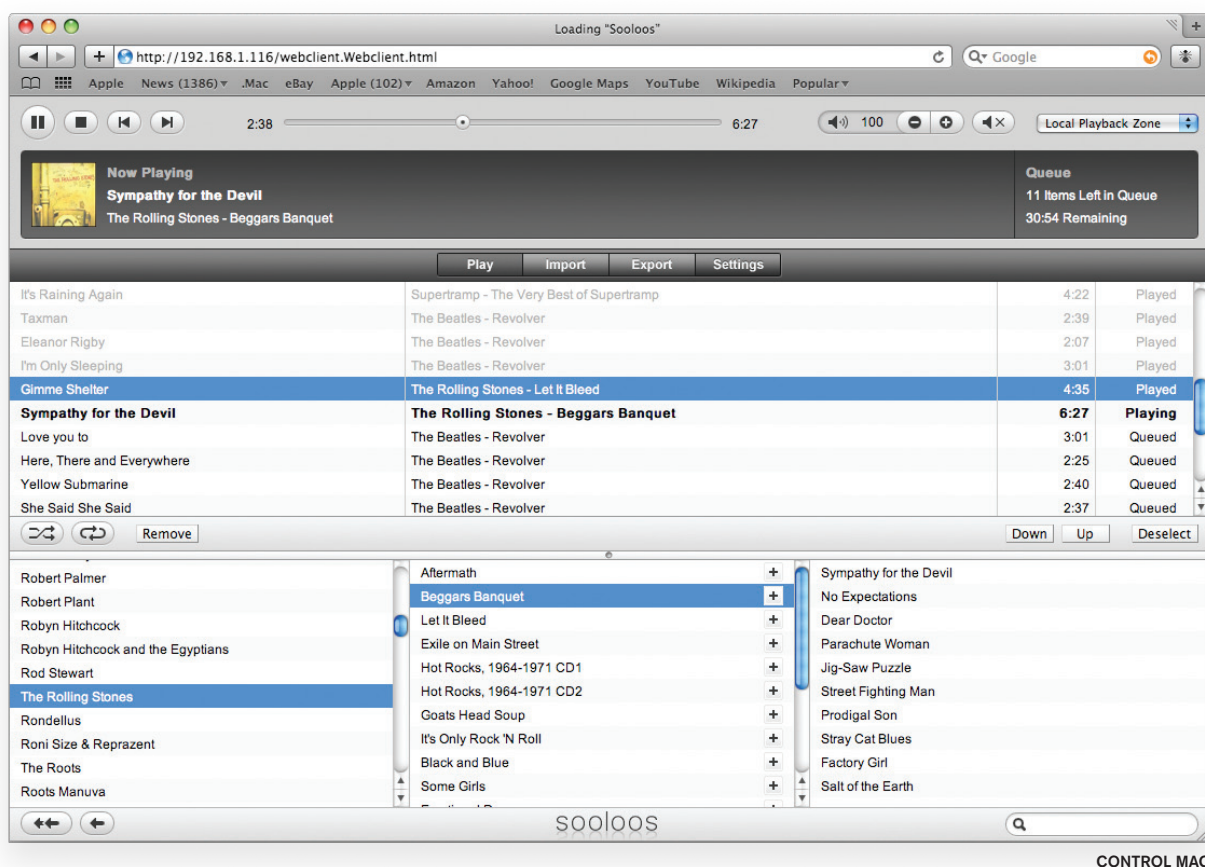
Adding Items to Focus: If you tap something in the Focus page, it highlights blue and is added to the Focus Criteria list.

Saved Focuses:[Load](#)[Save](#)

Save/Load Focus: This Feature allows you to create a complicated Focus and save it for later. Your saved focuses are available as a Swim option.

Excluded Item

Excluding Something from Focus: If you tap an item twice it will turn red and it will say "Exclude..." in the Focus Criteria. For example tap "Jazz" and then go to credits and search for "Kenny G" and tap his credit twice to make it turn red. Now you don't have to be embarrassed that Kenny G shows up in your Jazz swim.



Control Web:

To use your home computer or web-enabled mobile device as a system control, Tap "Settings" and then "Information" in the upper right hand corner of your Control 10. The Information screen includes an IP address and instructions on how to access your system via the internet.

Control Web enhancements include:

- A New Visual Theme and Improved Workflow
- Local Audio Streaming and Playback

Control Web cannot be used for importing CD's or exporting music.

Local Playback Zone

Local Streaming makes any computer sharing your system's network Meridian Sooloos zone. In the "Zones" dropdown at the upper right hand corner of the "Play" tab, select "Local Playback Zone" and you will be able to play music through your computer's speakers.

Control PC/Mac:

You no longer have to download the Control PC/Mac applications from the web. They are now accessed locally through your web browser.

Enter the IP address of your Source or Ensemble into the address bar of any browser.

Select the "Export" tab.

You will see links to download both the Control PC or Control Mac applications.

Control PC/Mac enhancements include:

- A New Visual Theme
- Improved import interface and workflow
- Local Audio Streaming and Playback
- Improved iTunes export integration
- High-resolution file import up to 96khz/24-bit
- New file format import support – including AAC, MP3, FLAC, WAV and Apple Lossless.
